counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has renewed his
prayer on the ground that some co-accused have been granted
bail and the informant in the present case has entered into a
compromise with the petitioner and the petitioner has not been
identified by the informant.

3. The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected as
the petitioner had participated in a *dacoity* and had similar or
serious antecedents.

4. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the
prayer for bail.

5. I have considered the submissions of the parties.

6. This is a case where the petitioner has committed



docoity and then he is trying to influence the trial which has resulted into the informant turning hostile and not identifying in the trial.

7. In a case where the petitioner is tampering with the evidence, this Court will not grant bail to the petitioner. Moreover, in such a serious case, the petitioner is tampering with the evidence, this Court will not grant bail to the petitioner.

8. In view of the above, this application is dismissed again.
