the learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Dalsingsarai P.S. Case No.178/2023 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian
Penal Code. It is next submitted that investigation of the case is
still going on.

3. The learned APP at the outset submits that the
offence for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against
the petitioners carries a punishment of less than 7 years to which
the learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute.

No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the said order.
