ORAL ORDER

4 23-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the Union of India.

2. The I.O. of the case has appeared. He submits that
the trial shall be concluded within 2-3 months as new Special
Court for the trial of NDPS cases has also been constituted and
now the trial is proceeding.

3. The recovery is huge and in these circumstances, I
am not inclined to grant bail to this petitioner for the present in
connection with Special (NDPS) Case No. 7/19. This
application is dismissed.

4. The trial is directed to be concluded within three
months from today failing which this Court will consider the



bail application of the petitioner in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in the Case of *Md. Muslim @ Hussasin Vs. State (NCT of Delhi)* reported in *2023 SCC Online SC 352*.

5. The Special Judge is directed to conclude the the trial at the earliest. The I.O. will take personal interest in the matter so that the petitioner is not detained any further as under trial.
