APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Noorsarai P.S. Case No. 204 of 2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is an
accused of looting a E-Rickshaw.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in jail since
09.06.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the
prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.



6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. 1st Class, Nalanda at Bihar Sharif in connection with Noorsarai P.S. Case No. 204 of 2023.

7. The petitioner will also mark attendance in Noorsarai Police Station, Nalanda on the first and third Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would be result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.
