2 07-02-2024 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner assaulted the informant by means of an axe due to which he sustained injury on his back side of the head.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He further submits that after investigation, police has



filed final form against the petitioner but differing with the same, learned Court below took cognizance against the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Jamo Bajar P.S. Case No.88 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
