The present LPA is filed in assailing the order of
learned Single Judge dated 26.11.2019 passed in CWJC No.
23276 of 2019. Perusal of the learned single judge order dated
26.11.2019, it is evident that appellant's service appeal is
pending consideration before the concerned appellate authority
on such ground the petitioner's writ petition was disposed of.



Therefore, we find there is no merit in the present LPA.
