The petitioner is directed to serve upon Ms. Debjani Sahu, Id. advocate, who ordinarily appears on behalf of the State. Her appearance may be regularized by the concerned authority.

The subject-matter of the revisional application relates to continuation of investigation relating to Kotulpur P.S. Case No. 182 of 2023 dated 22.6.2023.

I have perused the documents which have been enclosed along with the revisional application and I find that that, at this stage, the investigation of the case is continuing and the Id. Magistrate *in seisin* of the matter is aware regarding the same as he has called for I.O.'s report.

Records of the case reflect that the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail and there are some versions of the present petitioner but the same relates to question of facts.

In view of the nature of offence complained of, this court, at this stage, do not intend to enter into the truth or falsity of the contention so advanced.

However, it would be for the investigating agency to arrive at their conclusion at the stage of section 173 of the cr.p.c.

The petitioner would be at liberty to approach this court, if at all required, after the report under section 173 of the cr.p.c. is filed and the documents under sections 207 of the cr.p.c. is supplied to him.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 9 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending application (s), if any, is also disposed of.
