In Re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed in connection with Karimpur Police Station Case No. 245 of 2023 dated 14.11.2023 under Sections 341/325/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

In an incident of assault, the injured suffered a cut injury on the head and injury caused by bamboo rod on the wrist.

None of the injuries were classified as grievous hurt.

Considering the nature of the incident and the injury suffered, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of

the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
