The present criminal revision has been preferred against an order dated 9.11.2021 passed by the learned Sub-divisional Executive Magistrate Egra, District Purba Medinipur in Misc. Case No. 437 of 2021 under Section 144 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner but the learned counsel for the State is present.
