The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking electricity connection in CS Dag No. 4085 corresponding to LR Dag No. 4770 of Mouza – Manirampur (J.L. No. 64) within P.S. Chanditala, District Hooghly.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has made a representation to the Station Manager, Begampur Customer Care, West Bengal, i.e. respondent no. 5 and he states that he shall be satisfied if his representation is duly decided by the respondent no. 5 by affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as the private respondent and shall pass a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

Learned counsel for the respondent no. 5 agrees to the said proposition and states on instruction that they shall decide the representation within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of this order.
