1. When the matter is called on for hearing, the Union of India is represented through counsel.
2. Learned counsel for the Union of India submits that no notice of mentioning of the matter has been given to him.
3. That apart, it transpires from the mentioning slip attached to the file that the matter was mentioned for inclusion under the heading 'Upgraded Matters' on the ground of urgency. Despite the same, none appears for the petitioner at the time of call.
4. Accordingly, W.P.A. No. 681 of 2022 is dismissed for default without, however, any order as to costs.
