In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Medinipore All Women** Police Station Case No. **115 of 2023** dated **19.11.2023** under Sections **498A/323/307/509/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and **3/4** of the D.P. Act. (G.R. Case No.3267 of 2023).

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not cooperating with him.

At the invitation of the petitioners, we adjourned the matter on February 21, 2024 to explore the possibility of settlement.

Petitioners never attempted any settlement since the last order.

Apparently, the petitioners set up the ruse of settlement in order to obtain favourable orders from the Court.

Materials in the case diary suggest requirement of investigation.

Enlarging the petitioners on anticipatory bail will be inimical to such investigation.

Consequently, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

C.R.M. (A) 198 of 2024 is dismissed.
