CRM (SB) 23 of 2024

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Sonarpur P.S. Case No. 1269 of 2013 dated 25.11.2013 under sections 498A/406 of the IPC.**

The petitioner is in custody for about 32 days in connection with the instant case.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner has drawn the attention of the court that on 16.3.2022, at the first instance, warrant, proclamation and attachment was issued against the present petitioner.

The earlier orders reflect that the petitioner was represented in court.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Alok Kumar Das @ Alope Kumar Das shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Id. JM, 9th Court, Alipore.

If on bail, the petitioner shall once in a fortnight meet with the officer in charge of Sonarpur P.S. for a period of six months. The officer in charge of Sonarpur P.S. will submit a report of compliance on each and every month to the Id. JM, 9th Court, Alipore.

Accordingly, CRM(SB) 23 of 2024 is allowed.
