The police complaint was lodged pursuant to an order passed under Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C.

Injured suffered blunt trauma on the forehead and on the left upper eyebrow. Injury was not classified as grievous hurt.

Apparently other persons did not receive any external injury.

Considering the nature of the injuries and the incident, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the

investigation. The petitioner shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
