In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Bally** P.S. Case No.**116 of 2023** dated **02/09/2023** under Sections **498A/406/323/325/509/34** of the Indian Penal Code,1860 and Sections **3 and 4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act. G.R. Case No.4304 of 2023.

Petitioner before us is the mother-in-law.

Husband was arrested.

Allegations against the petitioner apparently are *omnibus* and general in nature.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the

jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 345 of 2024 is disposed of.
