Wife of the victim recorded a statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code claiming that the petitioner is one of the persons who fled from the place of occurrence. One of the injured also implicates the petitioner in the incident of assault leading to the murder of one person.

Police filed charge sheet.

Notwithstanding the fact that police filing charge sheet, in view of the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner in the incident as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

CRM (A) 357 of 2024 is dismissed.
