The present revisional application was preferred challenging the proceedings arising out of Raiganj P. S. Case No. 196 of 2017 dated 06-03-2017. Earlier there was a direction on 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2024.

Mr Mukherjee, learned senior advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the Office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta has refused to accept service without a certified copy of the order.
