C.R.M.(A) 420 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Suri** Police Station Case No. **353** of **2023** dated **17.08.2023** under Sections **365** and **34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, read with Sections **25/27** and **35** of the Arms Act, 1959..

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Co-accused were enlarged on anticipatory bail by the order dated January 17, 2024 passed in CRM(A) 116 of 2024, January 30, 2024 passed in CRM(A) 248 of 2024 and January 4, 2024 passed in CRM(A) 4481 of 2023.

Consequently, we extend same facility to the petitioner before us.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further

condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 420 of 2024 is disposed of.
