Case No.**01 of 2024** dated **01/01/2024** and notice issued 41(A) Cr.P.C. under Chandannagar Police Commissionerate and under Sections **420/406** of the Indian Penal Code. (CR Case No.1049 of 2023).

Demand draft of a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) was made over to the de facto complainant in Court on February 19, 2024 by the petitioner.

Apparently, the police compliant revolves around such amount.

State is represented.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from

the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 421 of 2024 is disposed of.
