The petitioner is granted liberty to take out appropriate application before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sealdah who would exercise his discretion in case any untoward incident happens during the continuance of the present proceedings. No interference is made at this stage.

Accordingly, the application being CRM (SB) 26 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
