Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate for the petitioner be kept with the record.

None appears on behalf of the State respondents in spite of service.

The petitioner was an approved Assistant Teacher of a secondary school and retired from her service on superannuation on May 31, 2010.

The Pension Payment Order of the petitioner was issued on June 04, 2015 in pursuance whereof she received the gratuity and the arrear Pension on December 12, 2015.

The petitioner is praying that a writ of mandamus be issued commanding the respondents to pay interest on the said amount of gratuity and arrear pension for the delayed payment.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay interest @ 8% per annum on the gratuity and the arrear amount of pension from the date of retirement of the petitioner till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A. 3502 of 2024 stands disposed of, with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
