Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner alleges inaction by the police in investigating Jiaganj PS Case No.294 dated 23.11.2022 under Sections 279//427/448/509/323/506 IPC.

Learned counsel appearing for the State relies on the report and submits that a charge-sheet being Jiaganj PS Case No.288 dated 30.11.2022 has been submitted in respect of the said FIR. In fact, a supplementary charge-sheet being No.43 dated 03.03.2023 has also been submitted.

It is not clear whether the petitioner was duly intimated about the submission of charge-sheet and supplementary charge-sheet.

If the de facto complainant had not been intimated about filing of such report, he shall be at liberty to file a protest petition before the trial court.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
