Jorabagan P.S. Case No. 102 of 2021 dated 24.9.2022 under sections 426/403/406/417/120B of the IPC pending before the Id. ACMM, Kolkata be hereby quashed.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 633 of 2024 along with CRAN 1 of 2024 is **allowed**.
