1. Petitioner is in custody for more than three years.

Accordingly, he prays for bail.

2. Learned Advocate for the State opposes the bail prayer. He contends date has been fixed for examination of the accused under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

4. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.
