It is submitted by the respondent no. 5 in the writ petition wherefrom the order under contempt emanates has been complied with. Photocopies of a bunch of documents have been placed before the Court by the respondent no. 5, which are taken on record.

On a perusal of the documents, it appears that a demand draft of Rs. 5,32,023/- dated 29th November, 2024 has been made over to the petitioner (employee).
