Defacto-complainant suffered injuries at the behest of the petitioner who is her husband. Neighbours implicate the petitioner before us in torturing the defacto-complainant both physically and mentally. They also implicate the petitioner in assaulting the defacto-complainant.

Police complaint was lodged within one year of marriage.

Petitioner allowed his earlier application being C.R.M. (A) 5168 of 2023 to be dismissed for default on January 30, 2024. Petitioner did not take any steps for getting such application restored.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

The application being **CRM (A) 654 of 2024** is dismissed.
