Petitioners before us are the in-laws of the defacto-complainant.

The defacto-complainant recorded a statement under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. implicating the in-laws including the petitioners before us and her husband, in physically and mentally torturing her.

The case diary contains materials with regard to the pregnancy of the defacto-complainant. There is a suggestion of termination of such pregnancy also.

Police complaint was lodged within two years of marriage.

Husband and the defacto-complainant is yet to participate in the investigation.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners and the prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

The application being **CRM (A) 660 of 2024** is dismissed.
