1. None appears on behalf of either of the parties. No accommodation is sought for.
2. Upon perusal of the records, it appears that on earlier occasion i.e. on 05.07.2024 when the revisional application was called, none appeared on behalf of either of the parties and no accommodation had also been sought for on behalf of the petitioner.
3. The case pertains to the year 2017.
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances and pendency of the case since 2017 and no one represented for the petitioner, it seems that the petitioner is no more interested to proceed with the instant case.
5. Accordingly, the instant revisional application being CRR 543 of 2017 is thus dismissed for default.
6. Connected application, if any, is also disposed of.
7. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
