In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Suri** Police Station Case No. **374** of **2023** dated **30/08/2023** under Sections **498A/323/307/406/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Sections **3/ 4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the de facto complainant implicates the petitioner, who is her husband in mentally and physically torturing her.

Police complaint was lodged within 1 and ½ years of marriage.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner in the incident, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.

CRM(A) 674 of 2024 is disposed of.
