Affidavit of service filed in Court today is kept with the record.

The learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that the wife of the petitioner no.1 was a Teacher of a school and retired in harness on 21.03.2022. Pension Payment Order was issued in favour of the petitioner on 02.11.2022 and the gratuity of the petitioner was released on 20.02.2023.

Although the petitioner was entitled to payment of pensionary benefit from Government Circular dated 13.04.2010, the same was not paid. By presenting this writ petition, the petitioner prays for an order on the respondents to award interest on delayed payment of arrear family pension.

I have heard the learned Advocate for the petitioner and have also considered the orders passed by different Hon'ble Judges on the writ petitions involving similar issues.

In view thereof, this writ petition stands disposed of with a direction upon the respondents and particularly the concerned Treasury Officer to pay interest to the petitioner on arrear family

pension @ 9% per annum from the date of death of the wife of the petitioner till the date of actual payment within 16 weeks from the date of service of an authenticated copy of this order failing which, additional interest @ 2% per annum shall be payable to the petitioner.

There will be no order as to costs.
