The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that in connection with M.E.X. Case No. 285 of 2022 pending before the Id. JM, 4th Court, Howrah, an arrear of Rs.40,000/- which has accrued, is still not being disbursed by the husband/o.p.

Ld. Advocate submits that the husband happens to be an IT professional and is purposely paying cryptically.

Having considered the submissions so advanced by the Id. Advocate for the petitioner, I direct the Id. Magistrate to fix one date in a month for the purpose of the present case and also direct the o.p./husband to clear all the arrears which have accrued in three monthly instalments.

The aforesaid amount would be along with the payment of regular maintenance so directed by the Id. Trial court.

The Id. Magistrate is directed to stick to the timeline and will not condone any reason assigned by the husband/o.p.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 847 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending application, if any, is also disposed of.
