This application is filed under Section 115 of
the Code of Civil Procedure challenging the impugned
order dated 19.12.2013 passed by the learned Civil Judge
(Junior Division), 3rd Court, Alipore in Title Suit No. 105
of 1995 analogously tried with Title Suit No. 106 of 1995
and Title Suit No. 107 of 1995.

In pursuance of the direction passed by this
Court learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite
party submitted the information slip and the server copies
of the judgements and orders passed in connection with
Title Suit No. 106 of 1995, Title Suit No. 105 of 1995 and
Title Suit No. 107 of 1995. It appears that the Title Suit
