1. The order dated 8th April, 2024 is mentioned for correction.

2. In the third line of the second paragraph of the first page of the order dated 8th April, 2024, the expression “and he died-in-harness on 15.02.2023.” shall stand deleted and be replaced by the expression “retired on 28th February, 2021”. In the fourth line of the second paragraph of the first page of the said order, the expression “the petitioner” shall stand deleted and be replaced by the expression “the petitioner’s husband”. In the fifth line of the second paragraph of the first page of the said order, the expression “the petitioner” shall stand deleted and be replaced by the expression “the petitioner’s husband”.
