Apparently, the victim committed suicide.

Husband is still in custody.

Materials in the case diary contain *omnibus* and general allegations as against the petitioners before us.

The police complaint was lodged six years after marriage.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner no.2 will report before the Investigating Officer once a week till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner nos.1 and 3 will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the

investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 752 of 2024 is, thus, disposed of.
