**C.R.M.(A) 802 of 2024**

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Santipur** Police Station Case No. **586** of **2022** dated **12.06.2022** under Sections **448/427/307/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections **3/ 4** of Explosive Substances Act, 1883.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Police filed charge-sheet.

Petitioner apparently stands on the same footing as that of co-accused who were granted anticipatory bail by the order dated January 2, 2023 passed in CRM(A) 6053 of 2022 and order dated January 9, 2023 passed in CRM(A) 64 of 2023.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before

the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 802 of 2024 is disposed of.
