In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the respondent no.3 is directed to dispose of the prayer made by the petitioners for modification of the issue framed in order of reference bearing no. KOL-700020/25/2023-Dy.CLC(C) dated 21st December, 2023

within a time frame but not beyond three months from the date of service of a copy of this order after giving the petitioners and respondent no.4 appropriate notice and hearing. The petitioners are also directed to serve a copy of this letter along with legible copies of all annexures on respondent no.4 by 30th April, 2024.

Nothing further remains to be adjudicated. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
