Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Case Diary contains a statement recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code which implicates the petitioner before us in attacking the victim with acid. Medical documents available in the Case Diary corroborate the fact that the victim suffered acid attack.

Notwithstanding the police filing charge-sheet, considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner as transpiring from the materials in the Case Dairy, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.

CRM(A) 900 of 2024 is disposed of.
