Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the earlier application for grant of anticipatory bail was not pressed on October 12, 2023.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the materials in the case diary. He submits that an eye-witness recorded a statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code and named the petitioner as the person involved in the incident of murder.

Considering the statement of the eye-witness as also other materials in the case diary, implicating the petitioner before us

in the incident of murder, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

CRM (A) 901 of 2024 is dismissed.
