1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner is present.
2. None appears on behalf of the opposite parties.
3. Mr. Arijit Sarkar, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner not pressed the challenge of this revisional application against the order No. 16 dated 8th March, 20224 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 3rd Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.
4. Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that he is not pressing the challenge of this revisional application but prays for only direction upon the Trial Court to dispose of the Title Suit as expeditiously as possible.
