**C.R.M.(A) 945 of 2024**

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Chhatna** Police Station Case No. **137** of **2023** dated **11.11.2023** under Sections **306/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 now pending before the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bankura.**

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Apparently, victim committed suicide.

The issue as to whether the petitioner abetted the commission of suicide or not may be decided at the trial.

Materials in the Case Diary do not suggest requirement of custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating

Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 945 of 2024 is disposed of.
