C.R.M.(A) 954 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Rampurhat** Police Station Case No. **410/2023** dated **09.12.2023** under Sections **498A/306/34** of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat, Birbhum.

Pursuant to our order dated March 27, 2024, State informed the de facto complainant.

None appears for the de facto complainant.

Police filed charge-sheet.

Husband was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court.

Other co-accuseds were granted anticipatory bail by the High Court.

Petitioners before us are a distant relative.

Materials in the Case Diary does not suggest requirement of placing the petitioner in custody at this stage.

Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of

Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 954 of 2024 is disposed of.
