Nobody appears on behalf of either of the parties on call. Even on earlier occasion no one represented the petitioners, no accommodation sought for.

This case pertains to the year 2018.

This is an application filed under section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 seeking quashing of complaint Case no. 6579C of 2014 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, at Howrah Sadar under sections 420/34 of the IPC.

However, no one represented the petitioners, no accommodation sought for in spite of giving several opportunities.

In view of the aforesaid facts it seems the petitioners have no more interest to proceed with the instant case.

Accordingly, **CRR 940 of 2018** is dismissed for default.

Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
