The petitioner has filed this application under section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code , 1973 seeking quashing of the proceeding being G.R. Case no. 512/2016 arising out of Lake Town Police Station case no. 97 dated 17.06.2016 under sections 354/506 of the IPC, 1860 pending before the learned Additional Chief Justice Magistrate at Bidhannagar, North 24 Parganas.
