C.R.M.(A) 993 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Cyber Police Station, New Delhi**, F.I.R. No.07 of **2024** dated **14/02/2024** under Sections **419/420/120B** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 along with Section **66(D)** of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

Petitioner prays for transit anticipatory bail.

The allegations as against the petitioner are serious. Apparently, petitioner is involved in a cyber crime where, money in excess of Rs.18 Lakhs was siphoned off. Grant of transit anticipatory bail will unnecessarily create avoidable hurdle in the investigation.

We are of the view that attempt to secure transit anticipatory bail is a ruse to circumvent the investigation, if possible.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.

CRM(A) 993 of 2024 is disposed of.
