**C.R.M. (A) 1024 of 2024**

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Bhatpara** Police Station Case No. **116 of 2024** dated **17.02.2024** under Sections **341/325/326/307/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barrackpore.**(GR Case No.1241 of 2024).

Some co-accuseds were granted bail by the jurisdictional Court.

The injury report states that the injured was drunk and that such injured suffered head injury.

Considering the nature of the incident and the materials in the case diary, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the

presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

**C.R.M. (A) 1024 of 2024** is, thus, disposed of.
