In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Mathura Pur** Police Station Case No. **331** of **2023** dated **27.12.2023** under Section **306/34** of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Diamond Harbour, South 24 Parganas.
And

In Re : **Bikram Naskar & Anr.** petitioners
Mr. Arun Halder
Mr. Surajit Basu ...for the petitioners
Mr. P.K. Dutta
Mr. A. Verma ...for the State

Apparently, the victim committed suicide.

Victim also left behind a suicide note.

As to whether the petitioners are involved in abetting the commission of such suicide, may be decided at the trial.

We, therefore, grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner no. 1 will report before the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and the petitioner no. 2 will

cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation. The petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
