1. We have considered the materials on record.
2. No one was injured in the course of the incident.
Custodial interrogation for progress of investigation is not necessary.
3. Accordingly, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that they shall appear before the

jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

5. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.
6. **C.R.M. (A) No. 1059 of 2024** is disposed of.
