Affidavit-of-service and report of the State filed
in Court today be taken on record.

The petitioner is the handicapped son of Late
Basanta Mahapatra, who was an Assistant Teacher of
Sat Sanda Primary School, District – Paschim
Medinipur. He retired on 30.09.1997 and died on
20.10.2014. The mother of the petitioner died on
03.02.2015. The petitioner applied for pension in
terms of the Circular of the State No. 325-SE(B)/M-
43/2003 dated 05.09.2005 which remain
unconsidered.

In those circumstances, the concerned District
Inspector of Schools (P.E.) shall consider the
petitioner's representation which is appearing at page
17 of the writ petition. For the said purpose, the
petitioner shall file a representation afresh enclosing
the details of the pension payment order of her late
father and other documents prescribed in the said

Circular within a period of fifteen days from date.

Upon receipt of the said representation, the concerned District Inspector of Schools (P.E.) shall dispose of the same with a reasoned order within a period of four weeks thereafter.

If the concerned District Inspector of Schools (P.E.) finds that the petitioner is entitled to get pension, the same shall be released to her as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one month thereafter.

The petitioner shall be entitled to receive all arrears in terms of such Circular dated 05.09.2005.

With the aforesaid directions, the instant writ petition shall stand disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
