Petitioner was aggrieved that his representations were not acted upon by the police authorities and to that effect they have suffered irreparable loss and injury particular with regard to the transfer of property on the basis of forged documents.

Mr. Ahmed, learned advocate appearing for the State has submitted a report. Report reflects that Sarsuna P.S Case No. 99/2024 has been registered

for investigation against respondent no. 5 and others. The said case was registered after getting information from the ADSR, Behala. More than five months have passed since the registration of the case.
