1. Petitioner contends co-accused has been granted pre arrest bail. He prays for similar relief.
2. Learned Lawyer for the State produces the case diary.
3. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner stands on the same footing with the co-accused who has been granted anticipatory bail.
4. Accordingly, we are inclined to grant similar relief to the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for

appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdiction Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

6. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
